

Diaper changing....

Do it **RIGHT**
to protect the kids!

1. CHECK to see if all your SUPPLIES are ready. Wash hands if needed.

2. Put GLOVES on.



3. Lay CHILD on changing area. NEVER leave a child UNATTENDED.

4. CLEAN child's bottom from front to back.

5. Remove soiled gloves.

6. Put disposable diapers & soiled gloves in a lined, COVERED trash can.

7. Use a disposable wipe to clean your hands and another to clean the child's hands (put wipes in the lined trash can).

8. DIAPER and/or dress the child.

9. WASH the CHILD'S hands with liquid soap & warm water for 20 seconds.

10. RETURN child to supervised area.



11. CLEAN diaper changing area with soap/water solution. Sanitize sink & any toys or objects with bleach water solution-let stand 10 seconds, wipe with paper towel. Spray sink/faucets with bleach water solution.

12. WASH your HANDS with liquid soap & warm water for 20 seconds.
